**To Whom It May Concern:****Re: Dr C Dostal**


Dr Dostal joined our paediatric department as a locum middle-grade specialist registrar for 2 weeks between 8<sup>th</sup> – 19<sup>th</sup> November 04.

During those 2 weeks, Dr Dostal was involved in looking after inpatients and those children presenting to the A & E Department. He also carried out long days on call activities.
